



GREEN SKILLS FOR CITIES

WORLD GAME

Instructions

Setup material: Number 3 A0-boards, post-it notes, and blue/green/red-colored markers

Duration: Maximum 2 hours in total.

Description of the activity:

1. Divide all students in three groups (blue, green and red) which will be used the assigned color for writing notes/sketches/diagrams
2. Each group of students will elect one moderator.
3. Each group will have 20' to discuss on one of the topics below and to describe the outcome of the discussion on the board. Text, diagrams, sketches and pictures will be allowed.
4. The next 20' each group will move to the next table and continue the discussion on the topic that was previously discussed. The moderator will help the transition by taking 5' to summarize the key elements of the debate to the next group.
5. The next 20' the groups will move to the remaining table so that each of them will have debated on all topics. A new moderator will be elected and explain the topic to the next group.
6. All groups will go back to their first table and take 20' to summarize and present the result of this work.
7. All groups will have 10' to present on their topic.
8. All students will ask questions and comment on the presentations.

Discussion topics:

- Group blue: "Nature-based solutions to foster resilience in urban areas".
- Group green: "The relationship between Nature-based solutions and ecosystem services".
- Group red: "Cost-benefit of Nature-based solutions in terms of climate change adaptation and mitigation".
